BUSINESS > 51%	
<p>The majority of the board, 51%, must be represented by individuals from businesses in the local area. 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MINIMUM BOARD MEMBERSHIP FOR COMPLIANCE

Assuming no representation of multiple categories occurs, the minimum size of a local WDB will be 23 members, per the below formula:
